

You Bring:

Keep in mind when packing that you are allowed 100 lbs per person for groceries and all of your gear

- Passport, photo identification, birth certificate. For additional border crossing information please click on our link- Border Information, you will find additional information as well as links to Canadian sites that provide even greater border information.
- groceries (We have several large grocery stores in Kenora where you can purchase whatever you need – lots of fish batter!)
- refreshments/beverages/bottled water
- water filter (MiniWorks Ex Microfilter)- optional
- cash, traveler's checks, credit card, check book
- fishing or hunting license
- Ontario card (current)
- extra set car keys
- life vests (PFD's - personal flotation devices- one per person)
- first aid kit
- whistle
- 50 ft rope
- Flashlight
- portable battery operated radio (one per group)
- suitable (warm) clothing for the time of year
- rain gear
- extra shoes
- sleeping bag
- pillow
- sunglasses
- glasses/reading glasses (might want to bring a spare too)
- suntan lotion
- insect repellent
- fishing tackle
- one light action rod with 10 lb test for walleyes and one medium action rod with 15 lb test for northern pike
- extra rod and reel – just in case

- fish stringers
- fish handling gloves
- live bait – you can purchase your bait from one of the bait shops in Kenora
- please note that nightcrawlers in artificial bedding is the only live bait that can be taken across the border
- tackle (spinners, lead jigs – mainly 3/8 oz.) Various sizes & colors, straight hooks, leaders, sinkers 1/4 oz.
- artificial lures – ie rapalas, fake worms & leeches etc
- portable depth-finder (ideally one per boat)
- scale/measuring tape
- compass, hand held gps
- walkie talkies
- landing nets
- filet knife
- whistle (one per boat)
- 50 ft rope (one per boat)
- Flashlight (one per boat)
- duct tape
- minnow buckets
- small cooler or ice chest for boat
- ziploc baggies, freezer baggies
- personal gear, including medications (aspirin)
- batteries
- binoculars
- camera (we hope you share some with us)
- playing cards
- personal towel and wash cloth
- personal soap and toiletries
- wet wipes (for the boat too– just in case)
- soap
- lip balm
- pocket knife
